Frequently Asked Questions

Is the North Las Vegas Police Department hiring Police or Corrections Officers?

No. Unfortunately, the City of North Las Vegas is experiencing the same economic challenges as most cities across the country, therefore, we are currently imposing a hiring freeze.

When will you be testing again?

At this time we are planning to test again in Fall of 2010. This could change so we recommend you monitor the web-site for any updates.

Can I submit an application now?

No. Applications are only accepted during scheduled testing cycles. At this time there is not a specific date schedule so applications will remain unavailable.

If I submit an interest card will I be notified when the next testing date will be?

Although it is our goal to notify those who submit an interest card, it is our recommendation that you monitor the web-site to ensure you do not miss any testing notifications.

Is there a lateral program?

Yes, but, to qualify you must be attempting to lateral from an in-state organization.

What does the Physical Agility Test consist of?

- *14" vertical jump
- *15 sit ups in one minute
- *18 pushups (no time limit)
- *300 meter run in 77 seconds
- *1.5 mile run in 17minutes 17 seconds

Is there an age cut off?

There is no age cap. We accept applicants of all ages.

What about civilian and non-sworn positions?

How long is the Academy?

The Police Academy is 22 weeks long and the Corrections Officer Academy is 9-11 weeks long.

Is it a live-in Academy?

No, you will drive to and from the Academy each day.

Do you get paid to attend the Academy?

Yes, You will start making your starting salary of \$56,871/year on your start date which is one week prior to the Academy starting.

Does NLVPD issue uniforms for the Academy?

Yes, You will be provided uniforms, duty weapon and holster. You will also be given a uniform allowance in June and December to cover other costs.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- *Must be 21 years old at time of application
- *High school Diploma or GED
- *Must be a U.S. Citizen
- *No conviction of any crime involving domestic violence.
- *No felony or Gross Misdemeanor convictions
- *Valid Driver's License
